

# KEY STAGE TWO DOUBLE PAGE SPREAD



**You are the editor of a book. You are going to create a double page spread. You have got some text but it is jumbled up and there are spelling mistakes in it. You have a layout with empty text boxes and picture boxes. You have a picture bank. Here's what you have to do:**

- put the sentences in order
- correct any mistakes
- use the text as part of a double page spread using text and pictures from the picture bank
- copy your corrected text and paste it into a text box
- drag and drop pictures and write captions for them
- make up headings and subheadings to make the page easy to understand.
- add a time line using the dates in the jumbled up text
